9 Three interesting innovations for 2008

The Marathon Tour of Coventry and Warwickshire to celebrate the Centenary of the first Marathon held in this country. One of our most respected promoters, COLIN KIRKHAM, (Coventry Godiva Harriers) is going to stage a very interesting five race series in the late spring which in aggregate constitutes 26.2 miles. There is a ceiling of 150 entries and the event should be very interesting.

MCAA, The East Midlands Region of EA and the West Midlands Region of EA have combined forces to raise the profile of some Open Track and Field Meetings and to raise the regional sprints standards by promoting some sprint Grand Prixes for U20 and Senior athletes over 100m, 200m and 400m. Birmingham Rowheath (5<sup>th</sup> May), Coventry (28<sup>th</sup> May), Worcester, Loughborough, Derby and Corby will share in a new series which will lead to Finals at the Birmingham Games at Alexander Stadium on 20<sup>th</sup> July.

The CSW Forum is close to finalising an U11 League. There will be two divisions with three fixtures each. This League is innovative in that Clubs can enter as many athletes as they wish and each athlete will do three events per meeting. More details to follow.
